1969 marked the beginning of a string of Safari successes for Nissan with the introduction of the 1600SSS (branded as a "510" in USA). Sporting a fully independent suspension and a 1,595cc L16 with dual Solex carburetors, the model made an immediate impact on the rally scene. A combination of speed, agility, and dependability led Nissan to capture six of the top 13 places as well as the Manufacturer's team trophy in the 1969 Safari, followed by outright victory and team trophy in 1970. Nissan's success was a PR sensation in Japan, driving sales, and even a feature film about the team's accomplishments.
