In 1958, a team from
Nissan entered two Datsun
210's (named Fuji-go and
Sakura-go) into the
Around-Australia Mobilgas
Trial: a 19-day, 10,000 mile
endurance rally spanning
the entire continent. In the

which caused the retirement
of nearly half the entrants,



the 210s both finished the rally, winning their class, and sparking the Works flame. From these humble beginnings, **Nissan Motorsports** was born.
