The S30 would debut as the Works team's first true multi-threat. With a new, powerful 6-cylinder 2400cc L24, the S30 proved to be able to compete successfully in endurance rallying, road rallying, and track racing. For international rallying events, one of multiple vehicle configurations and suspension setups was deployed, catering to expected course conditions. Early success came in the Safari, with the model winning its inaugural race on the continent, followed by a 3rd place finish in the ultra-competitive Monte-Carlo road rally the following year. 1973 saw the S30 repeat it's win in the Safari- a string of three overall wins in four years for Nissan.
