- The second of four 240Z Works Rally cars hand-assembled by Nissan for the 1971 Monte-Carlo Rally.
- Earliest example of six known surviving complete Works rally cars which still retain their original Works ZR-chassis. One of three Lightweight Spec cars retaining its rally trim.
- Last rallied in November 1971 due to upcoming 1972 FIA rules changes making special lightweight cars illegal. Seldom seen since.



- Original Lightweight Spec, with lightweight front fender panels, fiberglass hood, doors, and rear hatch, as well as acrylic side and rear windows.
- Orignal Monte-Carlo (Tarmac) Spec for road and snow rallying, supplied with lowered suspension, covered headlights, and headlight defog system. Shown today in 1971 Monte-Carlo livery, RAC (Forest) ride height and off-road tires.
- A largely Works feature-complete example.
